Purpose. This Request for Proposal ("Proposal") is designed to obtain bids from vendors ("Vendors) to provide taping services for New Orleans Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous ("Convention").

If accepted, the terms of the Proposal (or the terms negotiated therefrom) shall establish the Contract between the Vendor and NOACNA This Proposal will only become a valid Contract between the Vendor and NOACNA when signed by an authorized member of NOACNA's Board of Directors.

As a condition to any Proposal being considered and selected, neither the Vendor, nor anyone working with the Vendor, will possess, consume or otherwise engage in the use of any drugs (including alcohol) before or during performance. The Vendor further acknowledges that, if they remain at the Convention after services have been rendered, that they will remain bound not to possess, consume or otherwise engage in the use of any drugs (including alcohol) while on the premises of the Convention site.

**Indemnity.** All Vendors hereby agree to indemnify and hold NOACNA and the hosting Hotel harmless from any loss, liability, costs or damages arising from actual or threatened claims or causes of action associated with their equipment and/or personnel.
